BMC International Sea Cliff Climbing Meet 2013

12 – 19 May

The Count House, Bosigran, Cornwall

OVERVIEW

BMC International Meets are a truly unique experience. They are a great opportunity to make new friends and meet a varied bunch of climbers from 20 to 30 countries from around the world. The Meet will be located at the Count House in Bosigran, Cornwall, a 200-year-old building perched above Cornwall's finest granite cliff – Bosigran. We stay here as guests of the Climbers' Club who own the property. During the week international guests from a range of countries will be teamed up with British host climbers.

PROGRAMME OF EVENTS

- During the day our British based host climbers will take guests out and show them the full delights of the unique sea cliff climbing.
- Evening meals will be buffet style from 19.30 to 21.30. On some evenings there will be pub meals and presentations, some evenings will be left free.

EXPERIENCE

To get the most out of the Meet visiting climbers need to have experience of traditional lead climbing, that is placing your own gear/protection.

VENUE & DATES

- Venue – The Count House, Bosigran, Cornwall.
- Dates – Sunday 12 May to Sunday 19 May 2013.
- Arrival evening is Sunday 12 May (no climbing on this day).
- Departure day is Sunday 19 May (no climbing on this day).

TRAVEL & ACCOMMODATION

- Guests are responsible for making their own travel arrangements to the UK. Travel details will be sent to you at the end of January when places are confirmed.
- The Count House offers 'Alpine hut' style accommodation with shared rooms and showers.

COST

The event is highly subsidised by the BMC and there will be a nominal fee of £115/person to help offset the cost. The £115 fee includes all meals, accommodation and transfers from Penzance train station.

HOW TO APPLY

- International Federations are invited to send a maximum of two climbers. If possible one female and one male. Please note: only one Federation per country.
- Please complete the online form by no later than **18 January 2013**.
- Becky McGovern at the BMC will contact all applying Federations by email by 28 January. Please do not make any bookings (flights, trains etc) until you have had confirmation of your places.

- If the Meet is over subscribed then places will be reduced to one per country. Please state on the online form which climber will get the one place should places be reduced by putting their name in the 'Climber 1' box.
- PLEASE NOTE: emails do not always reach their destination. It is therefore your responsibility to contact Becky McGovern at the BMC if you have not received an email confirming your Federation's places on the Meet by 28 January. becky@thebmc.co.uk
