

Bouldering International Routesetting Course 2011 – FONTAINEBLEAU - FRA, December 5-10

This year the Bouldering International Routesetting Course will take place in Fontainebleau in the training center of the French bouldering team.

Each National Federation is in charge to apply for this course for its National Routesetters.

In 2012 the Lead International Routesetting Course will be held in France. The venue and details will be communicated by the end of 2011.

<u>Important note</u>: After the course and validations, it will be possible for the International Bouldering Routesetters to set in lead provided that they had 5 more practical experiences during an international lead competition with a positive report from an official Lead Chief Routesetter.

- your level in bouldering. At least 7c+
- your experiences as Routesetter before this course (national level is a minimum)

Routesetters will be evaluated in a continuum according to the boulders they will create and observing how they will work during test sessions with climbers of the French team.
