Lyon-Saint Exupery Airport

- Shuttle Ouibus (bus) just outside airport > Saint-Etienne Chateaucieux station > tramway (to Bellevue - stop Jean Jaurès) > 5 mn walk.
- Or Tram > Lyon Part-Dieu station > Train TER Saint-Etienne Chateaucieux station > tramway (to Bellevue – get off at Jean Jaurès) > 5 mn walk.

### By Train

TGV direct Paris - Saint-Etienne-Chateaucieux station > tramway (to Bellevue – get off at Jean Jaurès) > 5 mn walk.

### By car

Via Lyon (A6-A7) – Genève (A 42 – A46) – Chambéry (A41-A46) – Grenoble(A43-A46) – Valence (A7) – Saint Exupery Airport (A43-A46)
