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## 1. Event description

### 1.1. Age categories

- 1) U15 (born in 2012, 2013)
- 2) U13 (born in 2014, 2015)

### 1.2. Format summary

- 1) U15
  - a) Qualification round on the first day of the event (Saturday), according to 2026 YEC qualification rules, i.e. climbers start according to starting list, flash format with presentation videos, two courses (A and B), 3 boulders in course A, 2 boulders in course B. Rotation period is 4 min, + 15 sec to clear FOP. Girls and boys climb on separate 5-5 routes, parallel.
  - b) Final round on the second day of the event (Sunday), according to 2025 YEC final rules, for the best 10 climbers of the Qualification round of each gender, starting in reverse order (the one qualifying 10<sup>th</sup> from Qualifications starts first), 4 boulders, on-sight, 8 min observation, rotation period is 4 min, + 15 sec to clear FOP, once a climber starts on his/her first boulder, rests exactly one period between consecutive boulders.
- 2) U13
  - a) Individual event is on the first day of the competition (Saturday), a one round event (no final), Jam format, three consecutive starting groups, 10 boulders to climb, climbing time is 90 min, maximum 32 climbers per starting group, boys and girls are climbing in mixed starting groups. There will be some routes common, some routes having additional holds with different color for girls and some gender designated routes.
  - b) Team event on the second day of the competition (Sunday), for the best climbers of each team, same number of boys and girls form a team, two courses (A and B), they have limited time to climb the given boulders on each course, teams start from isolation, but team members can help each other, the goal is to maximize the result of the team.
  - c) Exact format TBD, working model is
    - i) team of four children is formed from best two U13 girls and boys based on Saturday's results of the national team (if someone leaves early, national team can name substitute)
    - ii) each course having two boulders to climb (whether common boulders for both genders or one common, one gender specific is under discussion)
    - iii) 10 or 15 min climbing time periods
    - iv) Teams follow 2025 YEC final logic, i.e. start on course A, have one rest period and then climb boulders of course B.

## 2. Participating countries, Quotas

### 2.1. Invited countries and regions

1. Invited countries are identical to Prague event: Austria, Bavaria, Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland, Slovakia, Slovenia + Ukraine
2. Additionally with wild card Romania and Serbia

### 2.2. Quotas

- 1) Principle is
  - a) invited country gets 5 quotas per category (altogether 40 quotas per category)
  - b) additional
    - i) 2 quotas per category for host country
    - ii) 6 wild card quotas per quotas to invite others at host country's wish
- 2) Altogether 48 climbers per category.

### 4. Registration, process, fees, discounts, deadlines

Registration process is similar to, principles and rules governing fees, discounts are identical to the Prague event.

#### 4.1. Registration process

- 1) Three phase registration process
  - a) First phase: In the first phase team officials (federations) register their competitors up to their given quota limits (till first phase registration deadline).
  - b) Second phase: If not all quotas are fulfilled by first phase registration deadline, in the second phase, remaining quota in each category will be offered to federations / teams filling their quotas to maximum level in the given category. In this second phase registration is open to team officials only, too.
  - c) Third phase, open registration: After the second phase registration deadline, if open quotas would still be remaining, in the third phase registration will be made available to public.
- 2) In the first and second phase team officials register their competitors by providing the list of athletes (including name, gender and date of birth) to [vr@mhssz.hu](mailto:vr@mhssz.hu)
- 3) In the third phase, registration will be made available to public using the Hungarian sports climbing infrastructure at <https://vr.mhssz.hu>

#### 4.2. Registration fee

There will be 2 types (principles) of registration fee. Federations who will send support staff (routesetter and/or judge(s)) will receive a discount for every participant but support staff is paid by or volunteering for sending federation. Federations who will

send athletes and coaches only will be asked to pay full registration fee. All Open registration applications (including late federation registrations) will have to pay full fee.

#### 4.3. Registration deadline

**Registration deadline (first phase registrations) is 27<sup>th</sup> of May, 2026, at 20:00.**

Phase two opens on 29<sup>th</sup> of May, 2026 and deadline is 3<sup>rd</sup> of June, 2026, at 20:00.

Phase three opens on 4<sup>th</sup> of June and registration closes on 18<sup>th</sup> of June, 2026, at 20:00.

**For national team registrations, registration fee will be invoiced by Hungary Climbing (MHSSZ) to the National Federation.** No cash-payments will be done on site.

### 5.3. Routesetting

The Head routesetter is going to be a Hungarian routesetter (as in Prague, for reasons of local knowledge, walls, holds). The routesetting team will consist of 7-8 members, out of which we are planning to incorporate / invite two routesetters from other countries. Testers will be Hungarian volunteers.

**Routesetting will start on Wednesday June 17<sup>th</sup> in the morning.**

### 5.4. Judges

We are planning to have a route / boulder judge for each boulder in U15 qualifications / U13 Jam round on Saturday, preferably two judges per boulder for U15 finals and U13 Team event on Sunday.

We would like to encourage regional level cooperation of judges in addition to routesetters, therefore international judges are welcome.

### 5.5. Food and Accommodation for international routesetters and judges

Hungary Climbing is providing accommodation, food for international routesetters and judges. All other expenses (travel, daily allowance / work fee) must be covered by delegating country or the officials / volunteers themselves.

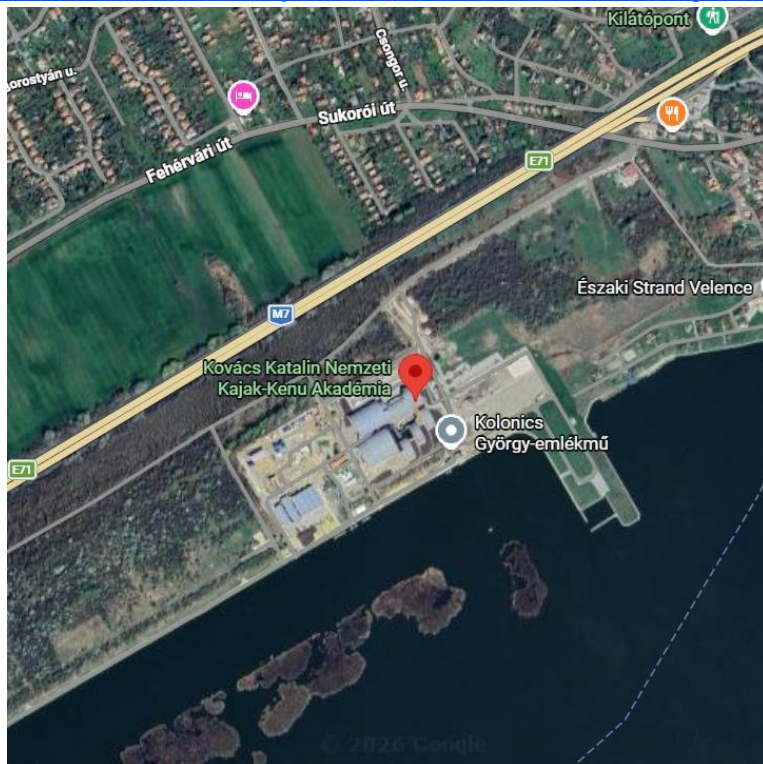

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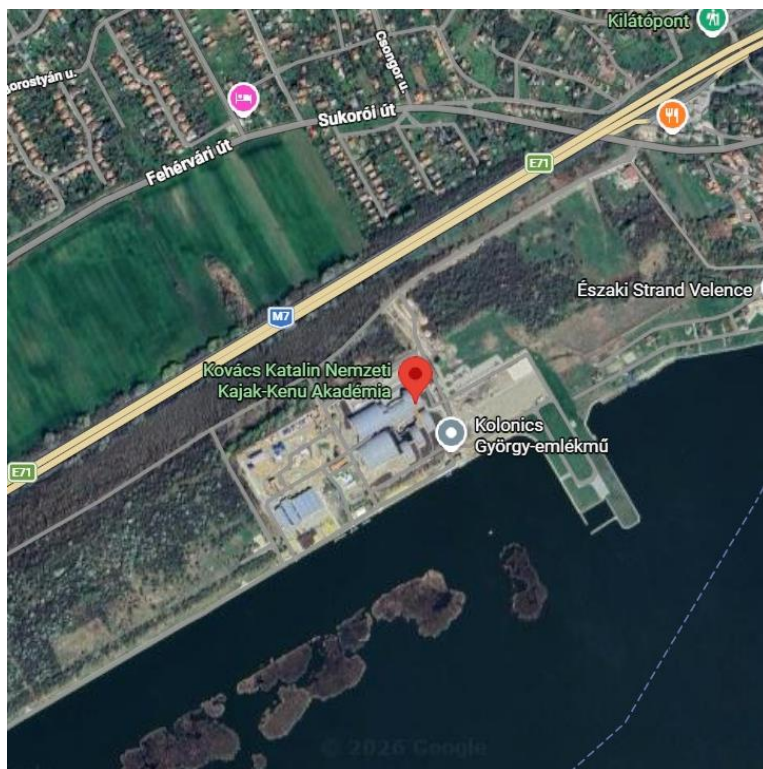
No tickets required.

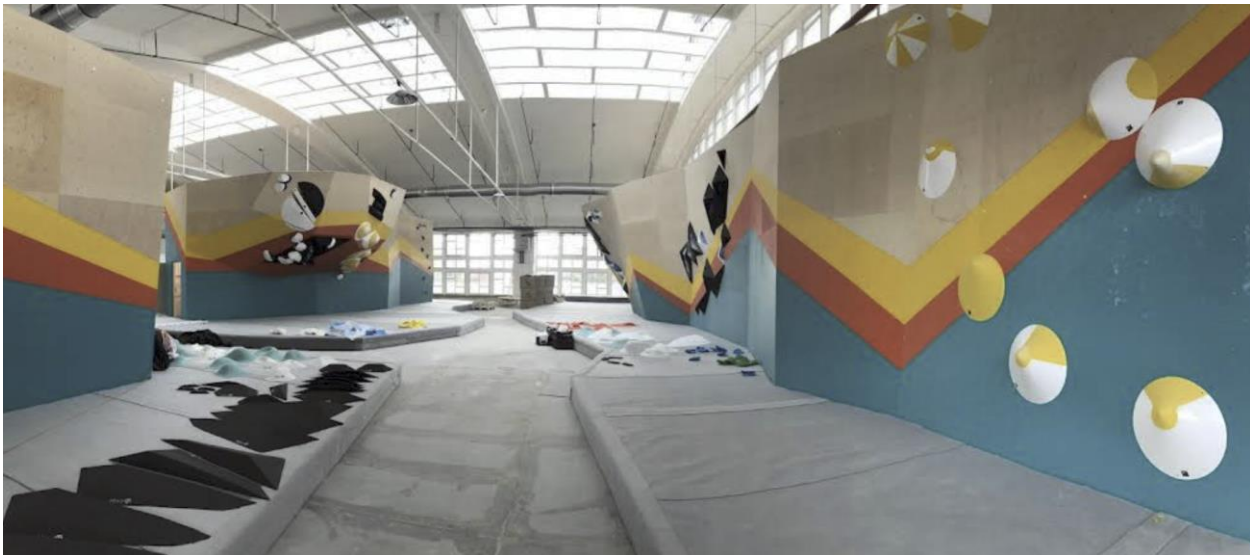
